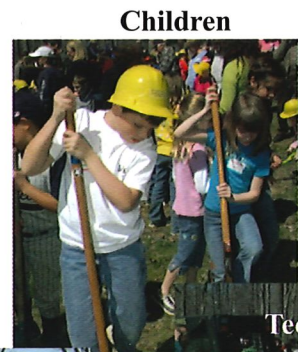

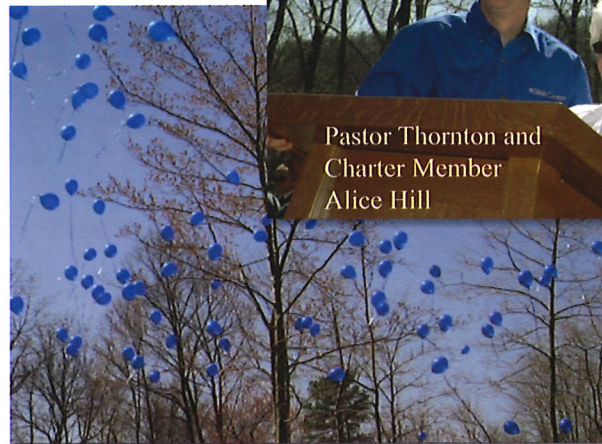

New Director of Operations

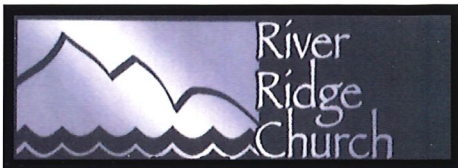

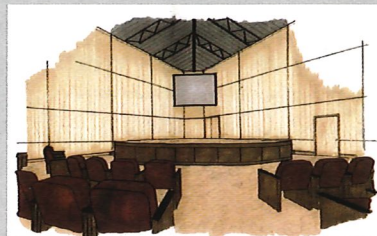
Tool Team
