The design of these buildings is unique, using traditional industrial materials with modern architectural forms. These facilities are typically constructed quickly and located in remote areas. It is Chesapeake's desire to incorporate low maintenance materials for their field offices.

The interior design includes finishes that are highly refined, but functional and adaptable for future expansion. This includes an extensive amount of casework work stations, state of the art computer equipment and magnetic walls to display graphics that are so important in Chesapeake's collaborative work environment.

The fabrication building has an overhead crane for use in handling large drilling components. There is a wash bay, with an environmental friendly recycling system, for washing the drilling equipment when it is brought in from the field. There are approximately three acres of graded and stoned lots for use as equipment lay down areas and fabrication zones.

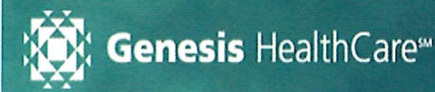

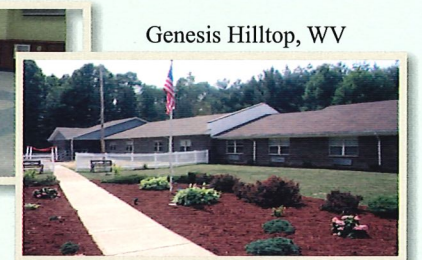
Pray Construction recently completed a dialysis unit at Genesis College View, Maryland and a new physical therapy unit at Genesis Loch Raven, Maryland.
